The Mentor Program serves Merced youth and its Mentors by giving them an opportunity to learn skills necessary for success.

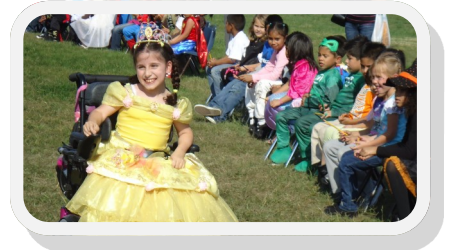
Working with our community partners, we help to teach children respect, responsibility, and how to be held accountable. We want each student to strive for a University Education in their future.
